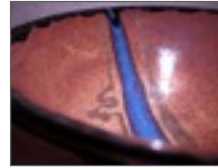
ADULT CLASS SCHEDULE 2010

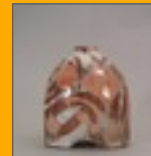

Registration payment of \$340.00 in full is required to reserve a seat in class and is non-refundable. **Adult class tuition is \$340 for a 10 week course PLUS firing fees per cubic inch for two firings which pays for clay, glazes and handling.** Students are required to supply their own tools. Tool kits will be available to be purchased for \$18. Tuition includes one two-hour class a week, clay, glazes, and open studio time. Students must sign in for open studio time. The open studio hours are subject to change **without notice.**
